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Liquid sunshine

This summer we are releasing five white wines perfectly suited for warm weather: an estate-grown 2024 Pinot Blanc, Navarro's value-packed 2024 Pinot Grigio, an Alsatian-inspired 2024 Edelzwicker with an enticing citrus-tropical profile, a richly textured 2023 *Mendocino* White Roan and a luscious 2024 *Late Harvest* Riesling. A 2024 rosé—produced entirely from Sangiovese grapes grown on vines planted decades ago—is also making a summer debut. Warm weather brings the release of Navarro's 2022 Barbera as well, plus a mouth-filling 2023 Grenache Noir. All five white wines and the Rosé of Sangiovese are offered with case specials for as little as \$15.00 per bottle, a great way to celebrate long days and gathering outside in balmy weather. Special pricing on samplers and six wines with full-case specials, as well as One-Cent ground shipping and reduced air freight for all 12-bottle orders, will be available until August 31.

2024 Riesling *Late Harvest* Anderson Valley, Mendocino



A Riesling cluster with the lower half affected by botrytis. After being infected with the noble rot, the weather warmed before the upper half was infected while the lower half shriveled, increasing grape sugars, acids and flavors. Because the weather remained dry, the desired rot never spread to the upper half.

Match sweet or savory

The starting sugar level in the grape juice for our 2024 *Late Harvest* Riesling was 30° Brix. We cool-fermented it in stainless steel and stopped the fermentation at around 20° Brix by chilling the wine to about 35°F. Anticipating it might be too

sweet given its acidity and alcohol, we also fermented some of the same juice to dryness. After tasting, we found the perfect balance came from adding 12% of the dry wine to the sweet. This *Late Harvest* Riesling is lush with delightful peach, apple and citrus notes. With its lovely balance, pair it with rich dishes and artisanal cheeses or on its own as a dessert wine.

Expanding repertoire

We’ve always adored Alsace’s white wines, especially the four noble varieties: Gewürztraminer, Riesling, Pinot Gris and Muscat Blanc. Our first Gewürztraminer grapes came from Edmeades Vineyard in 1976 and by 1978, we were harvesting our own. In the 1980s, we produced Riesling wines and a few years later Pinot Gris wines from Valley Foothills Vineyard’s grapes. These wines were a hit, so in the 1990s, we planted our own at Navarro along with Muscat Blanc. Two decades later we decided to plant Pinot Blanc vines at Navarro after our first bottling of this varietal—made in 2012 from grapes grown south of Ukiah—turned out great.

By 2023, our estate-grown Pinot Blanc was thriving with no need for outside grapes. This vintage, from two clones (60% ENTAV-54 and 40% FPS-5), was harvested at night, pressed, fermented

and aged *sur lie* for four months in French oak ovals. A tart embrace of green apple, lime and pineapple with a minerally, refreshing finish. Silver Medal winner.

Inside out

For more than 20 years, we've been buying Pinot Gris grapes from our neighbors at Valley Foothills Vineyard. The Ridge Block is always the first to be harvested and usually finds its way into Navarro's lush Pinot Gris. It's sheltered from the wind, with thin soils, so the grapes ripen early. The second field, the New Block, is situated by a creek bed with deeper soil and the grapes are harvested a week later with more acidity and less sugar, ideal for a crisp Pinot Grigio-styled wine. We picked the Ridge Block on

September 5, 2024, then came back a week later and were surprised to find the Grigio grapes in the New Block nearly as ripe as the Gris lot. This made the 2024 Pinot Grigio vintage a bit more medium-bodied than usual. It has lovely citrus blossom aromas and flavors of poached pear and lemon. Bone-dry and full of acidity, it's the perfect match for shrimp scampi or chicken piccata. Gold Medal winner.

Family favorite

We kicked off our blending tastings for the 2024 Edelzwicker in mid-March 2025. Typically, the main players are Gewürztraminer, Pinot Gris and Riesling. Since Pinot Gris is the most delicate of the three, our first blind tasting featured five different blends of Gewürztraminer and Riesling, ranging from 80% Gewürz with 20% Riesling to 80% Riesling with 20% Gewürz. The winning combo was a balanced 50/50 blend—each grape added something essential, with neither variety taking the lead. Next, we added Pinot Gris into the mix, and the best blend was a third of each grape. We also considered adding a touch of Pinot Blanc, thinking it

A little help from our friend

Marsanne is a white wine grape originally grown in the northern Rhône wine region in France, where it is frequently blended with Roussanne.

In fact these are the only two white varietals allowed in the northern Rhône appellations of Hermitage, Crozes-Hermitage and Saint-Joseph. The grapes require a warmer climate than Anderson Valley; consequently, we source these grapes from Spirit Canyon Vineyard located near the hills east of Ukiah. The Marsanne and Roussanne grapes were harvested on the same day, which gave us the opportunity to co-ferment the two varieties. The grapes were destemmed

and pressed, and the juice from the two varieties was

cool fermented in a French oak oval and then aged *sur lie* in the same cask for eight months. The combination of co-fermentation and extended *sur lie* aging produced a wine as bright as a summer day with dazzling texture and flavors suggesting hazelnut, pear and citrus. **Gold Medal winner. 92 points.**

New deal

2024 saw an early harvest in Hopland with the Sangiovese grapes coming in almost a month ahead of the previous year's vintage. The temperatures didn't drop enough overnight, so the grapes arrived at the winery at 60°F. We decided to destem and press the must after a quick 30-minute rest. Normally, we like the grapes to be a bit cooler, between 50°F and 55°F, to better control color and tannin extraction. The grape skin's pectolytic enzymes are

more active at warmer temperatures, releasing more color but also more astringent tannins, so we pressed earlier than normal. After pressing and cold-settling, we cool-fermented the juice in stainless steel then aged it in seasoned French oak barrels for four months. The result? A pale blush with vibrant tropical fruit, hints of fresh watermelon and a crisp, refreshing finish. **Double Gold Medal winner. 99 points.**

Remembering Peter

We knew Pete Chevalier as a farm advisor for years, long before we started buying his Barbera grapes. We even ran into him and his wife Lynn post-harvest on a beach in Hawaii over 20 years ago! Pete passed away just as his 2022 Barbera earned 97 points—he truly loved his vineyard and appreciated the recognition. Now, we're sourcing grapes from Lynn, who's carrying on the family legacy at their vineyard above Lake Mendocino in Calpella. The red volcanic soil there is perfect for inland red varieties. To keep the tannins smooth we fermented the grapes in small bins, like we do with our Pinot Noir, and pressed the
